Certification

Re-Certify Today

I'm sure you are getting a huge influx of recertification emails from SHRM lately. Make sure you keep your certifications current. SHRM and HRCI recertification matches your month of birth and are renewed every three years. The end of the year is a great time to make sure you have your credits from 2018 entered in the certification portals.

SHRM Certification information:

- 1) Log on to portal.shrm.org
- 2) Click on "Add PDCs" and then choose the PDC Category (Education, Organization, Profession)
- 3) Education credits can be entered by submitting the Activity ID. Organization and Profession credits will be manually entered.
- 4) When 60 credits are reached, click on "Apply for Recertification" link.

HRCI Certification information:

- Log on to hrci.org
- Click on "My Recertification Application"
- Click on "Add Activity" under the corresponding category (Pre-Approved, Continuing Education, Self-Directed, Professional Achievement"
- Once complete click on, "Complete Application"
